FINANCIAL OFFICER STATEMENT WILLIE LITTLE, JR FINANCIAL REPORT

Our sales of \$53.9k for August were \$4K

Greater than our weekly average for the month of July 2017. However, our Electronic Machines sales were down about \$1k which was offset by a strong Hall Rental activity of \$5k better than July. Our profit of \$1.35k was better than our August loss of \$2.77K by \$4.12K which was primarily due to reduction in our Post Renovation activity.

As we move forward nonessential expenditures must be closely scrutinized as we now face the challenge of replacing the loss of our Electronic Machines sales due to a recent audit by the Florida Department of Alcoholic Beverage & Tobacco who ruled out that our machine was illegal. We are currently researching other Electronic Machines alternatives.

As of this writing, we have relieved our Bar Consultant of his duties.

We are currently evaluating our current staff to assume most of his duties.

Your continued support of our post is much appreciated.
