FINANCIAL OFFICER STATEMENT WILLIE LITTLE, JR FINANCIAL REPORT

Our Financial for July was mixed. Our loss of \$2.8K primarily due to continue renovation of our sixty four

(64) year old facility which was over \$13K. This renovation activity will be significantly reduced over the next several months as we complete our current renovation projects. All future projects will require a rate-of return analysis.

I planned to provide some insight on how I see my role as a Financial Manager of this great institution. However, due to the unfortunate activities in our Lounge over the last two weeks that lead to the dismissal of one of our employees due to insubordination and two employees resigned voluntarily. I will provide that insight next month.

Back to the issues at hand, these employees adversely reacted to the implementation of a check-and balance procedure of the sales verification for each shift whereas a supervisor/manager removes the cash drawer from the register and both bartender and supervisor/manager verify the sales receipts for that shift.

We are aware that there are other issues that Lounge Committee must address due to recent decisions that we made. We will act upon them in a deliberated manner and despite the RHETORIC from our former employees regarding their love of their jobs and interactions with our Veterans and other patrons. Well, I'm OLD SCHOOL—ACTION SPEAK LOUDER THAN WORDS!! Less than twenty hours (20) after the implementation of a Universal Check—Balance Procedure, they abandoned their jobs with sole purposes of causing hardship to this Veterans organization that they profess to love.

We hopeful that our members and other patrons will continue to support us .
